1. Complete and pay \$20 to process the LSU-S PN application, available in our office, LSUS Technology Center-Room 141 and on our Nursing Website: Isus.edu/nursing (all required documents must be received at time of application submission)

## 2. The following documents are required:

- **Driver's License/** Photo Identification Card (valid)
- Official/ (Certified) Birth Certificate or passport with raised seal (we will copy)
- Official/ (Certified) high school transcripts/GED (through Parchment, Mail, E-script)
   (type LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY PRACTICAL NURSING in parchment)
- Official/ (Certified) transcripts from any colleges, universities or technical schools
- GPA 2.8 on high school or college transcript
- Official/ (Certified) scores on standardized testing (ACCUPLACER NEXT GEN, TABE, ACT); these scores should not be older than 3 years
- A letter of good standing from any nursing programs attended

If all above requirements are met, you will be contacted for the interview process. Class tentative start date: *January 2026*.

Accuplacer test is offered at LSUS, go to Isus.edu/continuing-ed/testing-center, complete form to request test or call Testing Center at 318-795-4226. The test price is \$45 for all three parts, or \$15 per part. Students must pass Math, Reading and Language with the minimum scores required.
