

TEPAR Application Process

1. You must apply to TEPAR by semester deadline **prior** to semester registering for TEPAR restricted courses as long as you have met all the TEPAR requirements*:
 - a. 2.5 overall GPA
 - b. Communications 130 with grade of C or higher
 - c. English 105 and English 115 with grade of C or higher
 - d. Passing scores on PRAXIS Core Academic Skills in Reading, Writing, and Math or an ACT composite score of 22 or higher or or a SAT combined verbal/critical reading and math score of 1100 or higher (New SAT) or 1030 or higher (pre-March 2016 SAT).
 - e. Completion of 45 semester hours or more
2. You must have an active TaskStream account to submit a TEPAR application. Go to www.taskstream.com to set up an account. TaskStream is a subscription-based. A credit or debit card is required to set up an account. Enroll in the TEPAR Application DRF with the code assigned to the semester (i.e. TEPARFALL2020).
3. Upload all the required documentation and complete all questions. Do not submit the TEPAR application until ALL of your information is completed.
4. Your application will be reviewed by the TEPAR Committee following the semester deadline. You will be notified of the application status via TaskStream message.

*You *must* be admitted to TEPAR **prior** to advisement for registration in TEPAR restricted courses.
