PURPOSE**

To set forth the process by which the campus responds to and complies with LSU System and/or Louisiana Board of Regents review of “low-completer” degree programs.

**II. POLICY**

All academic programs at LSU Shreveport are evaluated on a continual basis to ensure academic rigor, accessibility for students, and compliance with LSU System and Louisiana Board of Regents regulations. In accordance with the Louisiana Board of Regents “low-completer” policy, academic programs will be reviewed at regular intervals to identify those falling below a designated threshold level of completers. If it is determined that such programs exist, the institution will submit to the Board of Regents a proposal to continue, consolidate, or terminate each program. Once the proposed program action has been approved by the Board of Regents, the campus will be required to complete its regular Courses and Curriculum review and approval process.
